A competition between District of Kent farms and West Coast Robotics.

**Prize Money:** 1st Place – \$600; 2nd place – \$300; 3rd place – \$100

Farm: must have their residence and farm in the District of Kent and must grow or produce agricultural products for the public.

<u>Farm Team</u>: up to 6 long-term employees (6+ months) and/or immediate family living and/or working on the farm. Names must be submitted with registration.

West Coast Robotics Team: up to 6 employees who have lived in the District of Kent for 6 months or more. Names must be submitted with registration.

The individual farm with the most overall points will be crowned the Top Farm in the District of Kent. The best placings out of a possible ten categories will be used to determine first, second, and third places. Points will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> 20 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> 15 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> 10 points. 5 participation points will be awarded to each farm not placing in each class. Entry in every class is not mandatory.

Exhibit classes must be brought to the Agricultural Hall on Thursday, September 21 between 3-8pm. Competitions will take place on Fair day.

## **CLASS: COMPETITIONS**

- Square bale toss how high can a farmer toss a square bale?
- 3. Tractor Reverse Obstacle Course how accurately and quickly can the farmer reverse a tractor and implement through an obstacle course?

#### **CLASS: EXHIBITS**

- 5. One agricultural entry (i.e., field produce, fruit, vegetable, eggs, honey) that is sourced from the individual District of Kent farm.
- 6. One edible fruit dessert made from fruit grown on any District of Kent farm.
- 7. One edible vegetable item made from vegetables grown on any District of Kent farm (i.e., carrot cake, potato salad).
- 8. One preserved entry (canned, dehydrated, smoked) from items produced on any District of Kent farm.
- 9. Wheelbarrow display a selection of items (minimum 6) produced on <u>any</u> District of Kent farm, judged for quality and attractiveness.
